

HSCRC Proposed Work Group Activities

- ▶ Work groups to focus on more detailed and technical aspects of implementation
- ▶ Work groups to begin in 2014
- ▶ All work groups to address:
 - ▶ Statutory and/or regulatory changes that may be needed
 - ▶ Infrastructure needs

HSCRC Proposed Work Group Focus

Physician Alignment & Engagement

- ▶ Alignment with emerging physician models
- ▶ Shared savings
- ▶ Care improvement opportunities
- ▶ Care coordination opportunities
- ▶ Post acute care alignment

Performance Improvement & Measurement

- ▶ Core requirements for New Model (Reduce PAVs)
 - ▶ MHACs
 - ▶ Readmissions
 - ▶ Other potentially avoidable use
 - ▶ Care coordination
- ▶ Quality, outcomes, and population health focus—patient centered and population based
- ▶ Value measures (integration of cost and quality)
